# V. Principal's Report

- Mr. MacGaffey thanked board members, staff, parents and Mr. Mora for their presence in the meeting, and he expressed gratitude to the staff who have been helping out on campus and from home and the teachers during this time of distance learning.
- Mr. MacGaffey reported on: a successful visit from the fire marshal no issues or infractions; Discovery's 2<sup>nd</sup> distribution of materials day last Friday, October 9<sup>th</sup>; the new Student Council members; the use of i-Ready Math and the start of i-Ready reading; the focus on individual students for whom distance learning is not working with the goal of gathering a team to conduct the appropriate outreach and support for these students and families; his participation in various cohorts, the rotation schedule of classroom observations by the leadership team; Discovery's rank of #3 in District attendance; Discovery's active GATE and Robotics clubs even during distance learning
- Mr. MacGaffey shared that they are looking at other options to hold the virtual board meetings
- Mr. MacGaffey shared that Discovery has been given the green light to begin the planning process for reopening.

## VI. Budget Update

• Mr. MacGaffey presented the updated budget report on the unaudited actuals from the 2019-20 school year: the revenue, expenditures, including the deficit spending, and concluded by underlining the nearly 19% reserve.

# VII. DCS Student, Family & Teacher Voices

 Mr Espinoza presented the results of the student survey, the parent survey and the staff survey related to the current distance learning model and the possible reopening of the school. He explains the importance of communication and transparency within the community. He shared a video presentation: Student Voices II.

• Mr. MacGaffey showed the job description and explained how the need for this position came about from input from our parents and our staff in meetings and surveys, and had been approved as part of our Learning Continuity Plan in September 2020.

- Dr. Richison asked how we can respond to our students and design a hybrid model with their feedback in mind, suggesting to start small and then scale up. She shared that October is national school Principals month and thanked both Mr. MacGaffey and Mr. Espinoza.
- Mrs. Carroll shares how impressed she was with the group of students who participated
  and thanks the administrators for their time and hours and shares her appreciation with
  families and staff. She also commends teachers, parents, and students and
  administrators for keeping up with these times.
