V. Executive Director's Report

(Information/Report)

- Mr. MacGaffey expressed how amazing the Drama presentation was to witness and enjoyed watching their presentation.
- On behalf of Discovery Staff, Mr. MacGaffey thanked our Board for the valentines day lunch they prepared for staff and for the gift provided to each of them.
- Discovery had a successful launch of our Thought Exchange survey and our LCAP meetings have begun and they are moving along well.
- Continuing our two-way communication, Mr. MacGaffey shared that Discovery just had a successful DELAC meeting and Coffee with Admin, and expressed that it is always great to hear from our parents.
- Mr. MacGaffey noted that the Twig Science adoption cost, which is item VI on our agenda, will be a little less than what is written on our agenda.
- We have also included for approval on item X, a request for Sprockids bike trail riding club to expand its number of student groups. This is a great opportunity for our students.
- We have begun our ELPAC testing today and are very appreciative of our teachers, of Mrs. Ulloa our ELL IA and Mrs. Alamo, who is helping launch the testing this week.
- Mr. MacGaffey expressed his appreciation for our partnership with UCSD. Our Robotics teacher has recently reached out to Dr. Appel to coordinate a visit to their science lab.
- The district started a food recycling initiative. Mr. MacGaffey shared that Discovery is leading the way and has started to work with students in phase 2 of the initiative, which includes teaching students to sort trash, recyclables, and food compost. Though it was an initial challenge, it is amazing now how far our students have come and how well they have learned this new system. Discovery is excitedly rising to that challenge and leading the way for other schools in the district.
